Ballew Memorial scholarship which provides financial assistance to a Jackson parish student pursuing a vocational education. 100% of all donations stay in Jackson Parish.



Habitat for Humanity is a non-profit Christian housing ministry that seeks to eliminate poverty and substandard housing by building safe and affordable housing in areas of great need. We provide housing to those in the low income range that are seeking to improve their lives and their children's lives by owning a home. Habitat is not a giveaway program, but a program that sells the home to qualified partner families. We finance the home for them at building cost with no interest. The homeowner is required to work 250 sweat equity hours in the home and attend 12 weeks of financial and home ownership classes. We not only provide a good home, but we also teach our families how to budget and be successful homeowners. We are thrilled to be able to build our first home here in Jackson parish. With your help, we can make it happen.
